The Transition Age (TAY) Youth WISE program at Community Youth Services (CYS) is serving Medicaid eligible youth ages 15 to 20 in Thurston and Mason counties. We have limited availability for youth without Medicaid. TAY offers a team approach when and where a youth needs it, including in-person, virtual and non-traditional hours. We work with youth to create a plan that will help them to stabilize and reach their goals.

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The Multisystemic Therapy (MST) WISE program at CYS serving youth ages 12 to 17 continues to use a hybrid approach of offering in-person and telehealth sessions during the pandemic.
