The Transition Age (TAY) Youth WISe program at Community Youth Services (CYS) serving Medicaid eligible youth ages 15 to 20 has openings. We have three clinical supervisors and are building strong therapeutic teams, focused on participant care. This youth-guided intensive program uses a hybrid model that includes in-person and a tele-health solution.

The Multisystemic Therapy (MST) WISe program at CYS serving youth ages 12 to 17 is now able to accept referrals for youth who are diagnosed on level 1 of the Autism Spectrum Disorder. We also continue to use a hybrid approach of offering in-person and telehealth sessions during the pandemic. MST currently has one therapist, and a second therapist has accepted an offer of employment and will be starting soon. We are still actively recruiting for therapist candidates and are excited to be building our team back up
